The caleidoscope of Taboo - Open University course
Making and Breaking: The kaleidoscope of taboo The relationship between taboo and health is complex: as we know from anthropological case studies, taboos are sometimes needed to maintain health, while at other times they need to be broken to achieve the same. Focusing on this dilemma from the perspective of physical and mental health respectively, with examples discussing individual as well as communal aspects of health, this series of lectures will provide an interdisciplinary range of approaches scrutinizing the overarching topic: taboo. Planned perspectives include cultural studies, musicology, sociology, literary theory, communication, media, economics, theatre, medical humanities, religious studies and philosophy. Confirmed lectures and lecturers so far are the following: dr. Ira Prodanov, UNS: Taboo Or Not Taboo, That Is The Question! - The Status Of Religious Music In A Communist Regime prof. Attila Kiss: English Renaissance Revenge Tragedy and Political Taboos dr. Larisa Kocic-Zámbó, USZ: Is Sex Still a Taboo? Sex Education and Fan Fiction Culture prof. János Nagyillés, USZ: Sex as Taboo - Nicolas Chorier's Satyra Sotadica and The Birth of Porn This course runs as an edition of the English language Open University series, organized by the University of Szeged as a Eugloh program, addressing the motto of Eugloh: "European University Allience for Global Health". This is a general elective course open to all levels of study within the student body of the EUGLOH consortium, with the primary target being undergraduates of all backgrounds. Talks are normally 45 minutes long, with 15 minutes Q and A at the end, and are streamed through a closed channel on YouTube. Asking questions is possible and encouraged during the live stream. Insightful and relevant questions may earn students extra points towards the final grade. The lectures are available for viewing after the event. Live streaming time slots: Thursdays 18-19 CET February-May 2024. The series closes with an online written test with multiple choice questions based on the lectures with questions from each talk. Exam questions concentrate on the main argument rather than small details. No other lecture material is needed for preparation. PPTs are shared depending on the speakers' preference, but the presentation slides are obviously available through the recorded lectures.
