	covered will include core elements of written
	and oral communication, such as purpose,

	verbal strategies. Techniques of stress
	management and relaxation will also be
	presented and practiced, and tips for better
	focusing will be discussed. Students will
	regularly be required to draft short oral and written, working individually as well as in
	groups, rehearsing and giving feedback to each
	other in class and as homework activities. The
